

Anti-Weapon/Knife Crime Pack

This is your Aberdeen City Council Anti-Weapon/Knife Crime Pack which is being distributed to all City schools. Electronic copies of all documents and resources are available on Abernet www.abernet.org. You will find the following enclosed:-

- 'No Weapons' posters which should be displayed throughout the school. In primary there is also an early stages version.
- Parental leaflet- distribute to all parents one per family.
- Aberdeen City Council letter - rules on weapon/knife crime - Distribute letter to all parents, one per pupil. Record all agreements returned and signed on SEEMis using the tab titled ACC extra items.
- 'Zero Tolerance' certificate to be displayed in school
- Agenda Item for Pupil Council to be discussed at your next pupil group and all submissions should be returned to Catwalker@aberdeen.city.gov.uk by 26/4/17
- Draft policy – consult with staff and all comments on the draft policy to be returned to Catwalker@aberdeencity.gov.uk by 30/4/17
- Head Teacher Assembly to introduce school pack
- Anti-weapon/knife lesson booklet to be delivered to P7 pupils. For the remainder of this school year only, these lessons can be delivered to Secondary1 pupils.
- Stickers/pencils distributed to P4-7 and S1- S6.
- ASN cards – flash cards to be used throughout school to aid pupils with additional support needs.

Future Developments – Further educational resources will be developed for P1 – P6 stages and for S2 - S4 pupils
